- **On-Site Job-Training:**
Students will have access to job training experience at VA-Palo Alto with support from teacher and/or job coach.
- **Social/Employment Skills Instruction:**
Students will develop a career portfolio, practice social and employment skills that will better prepare students for real life experiences throughout their adulthood.
- **Assistance with Job-Placement Upon Completion of the Program:** Students will receive support from PACTS staff in applying and obtaining paid employment at the completion of the program.

Student IT Intern

As a volunteer IT intern, students will have an opportunity to work closely with the hospital IT department and gain valuable work experience in the field of Information and Technology with support from an on-site job coach.

Student Administration Intern

As Volunteer Interns, students will have an opportunity to work closely with the Fisher house manager and gain valuable experience in the field of managing a small home like hotel with twenty plus rooms. They will meet and greet guests, do supply inventory, organize and restock supplies in common guest rooms, host occasional events for guests or conduct special projects such as creating flyers or making flower arrangements for the Fisher House with support from an on-site job coach.
